

# Montrose Area School District Quarantine Procedures

**Individuals who have been determined to be a close contact will need to quarantine as listed below:**

**The close contact definition is generally 15 consecutive minutes. However, there are circumstances where 15 cumulative minutes, or less than 15 minutes, may be used.**

- Fully vaccinated individuals (proof of vaccination required) who are not experiencing any symptoms:
  - **Do not need to quarantine as long as they remain asymptomatic**
    - **Should be referred for testing 2-5 days after exposure**
    - **If they receive a positive test, they will need to quarantine as directed by DOH.**
  
- Individuals who have previously tested positive (within the last 90 days), and not experiencing any symptoms:
  - **Do not need to quarantine as long as they remain asymptomatic**
    - **Should be referred for testing 2-5 days after exposure**
    - **If they receive a positive test, they will need to quarantine as directed by DOH.**
  
- Adults (non-students) who are not vaccinated **will be required to quarantine as follows**:
  - Quarantine for 10 days from date of exposure, as long as they are symptom free. Individuals should continue to monitor for symptoms through day 14.Or...
  - Quarantine until they receive a negative test on or after day 5. They may return on day 8.
  
- Students in K-12 indoor classroom setting:
  - **the close contact definition does not include students who were within 3 to 6 feet of an infected student if both the infected student and exposed student(s) correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time.** (CDC and PA DOH)
